The Department of Philosophy in the academic year 2014-15 opened up to new arenas with varied activities and developments taking place. With a BA in Philosophy, last year the department started its Post-graduate course i.e., MA in Philosophy, a milestone in the history of our Department.

Various activities:

 An Inter-Collegiate Paper Presentation Competition was organized for Post – Graduate Philosophy Students on 21st Feb 2014. In all 28 students from different colleges participated in the competition who
